**TENDER FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICES TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON
VEHICLE LOADING TRENDS IN KENYA**

KRB received queries from one of the firms on 1st March 2019. The following are responses to the queries raised:

QUERY	KRB RESPONSE
1. Clause 4.6 of the TOR refers to a quarterly schedule of monitoring, where the sites to be monitored shall be on 'a rotational basis'. Could you clarify whether the sites to be monitored on a rotational basis are the 20 sites referred to in Clause 4.4, or only KeNHA static weighbridges referred to in Clause 4.5, or both;	Both
2. In reference to (1) above, are there other static/mobile weighbridges in other road agency networks which should be monitored?	None
3. Clause 7.1 (i) and 10.3 say that KRB will provide 2 no. mobile weighbridge equipment for use by the consultant. Could the client consider increasing this number to at least 6 so as to allow multiple teams on site at any one time; and,	KRB has 2 No. mobile weighbridges. KRB will not purchase additional equipment since the two are considered adequate for the assignment.
4. If the number of mobile weighbridges is increased, the client should also consider increasing the provisional sum allowed for calibration and maintenance in Clause 7.1 (ii).	Refer to response 3 above.
